How it pertains to General Institute Requirements (GIRs)

Major (Full)	Joint Major
<p>MAY NOT count Literature electives toward the HASS Concentration Requirement. Concentration must be in a different HASS field.</p>	<p>MAY count Literature electives toward the HASS Concentration requirement.</p> <p>MAY Concentrate in Literature</p>
<p>*MAY “double count” any 3 of the 8 HASS subjects toward the Literature major requirements.</p>	<p>*MAY “double count” 6 of the 8 HASS subjects toward Literature major requirements.</p>

***(Double-counting fulfills the intellectual area of focus; units do not count twice, and the difference is made up in additional elective credit, for the total units beyond GIRs.)**

- Freshmen Seminars, Freshmen Advisor Seminars, subjects taken Pass/Fail by upperclasspersons, and Special Topics subjects receiving fewer than 6 units are not eligible for credit towards the major.
