To Minor student must meet a designated Literature Minor Advisor to plan out the course of study, and to submit the Proposal for Minor form to both the Literature Headquarters & SHASS Academic Administrator office.

# TIER 1 (INTRODUCTORY): AT LEAST (1) & NO MORE THAN (2) COURSES FROM THE INTRODUCTORY TIERS OF LITERATURE CURRICULUM

TIER 2 (SAMPLINGS & INTERMEDIATE): (1-2)
INTERMEDIATE SUBJECTS; (2) SIX-UNIT
SAMPLING SUBJECTS MAY BE COMBINED AS
(1) TWELVE-UNIT SUBJECT

TIER 3 (SEMINARS): 2 SEMINAR SUBJECTS

\*AT LEAST (2) SUBJECTS IN THE MINOR PROGRAM MUST CENTER ON MATERIALS DATING BEFORE 1900

### FILM FOCUS

- (3) REQUIRED SUBJECTS: TAKEN FROM THE INTRODUCTORY, INTERMEDIATE & SEMINAR TIERS OF LITERATURE CURRICULUM,

  PREFERABLY IN SEQUENCE
- (3) RESTRICTED ELECTIVES: TO BE CHOSEN BY THE STUDENT IN CLOSE CONSULTATION WITH A MINOR ADVISOR

SUBJECTS MAY BE REPEATED FOR CREDIT IF
THE CONTENT IS DIFFERENT AND CAN BE
TAKEN MORE THAN ONCE TO FULFILL A
RESTRICTED ELECTIVE TOWARDS THE MINOR

### CONCENTRATING

CONCENTRATORS MUST COMPLETE A TOTAL OF 3 SUBJECTS

Tier 2 (Samplings & Intermediate): one or two intermediate subjects, two six-unit sampling subjects may be combined as one twelve-unit subject

Tier 3 (Seminars): one seminar subject
